DIWALI

Diwali, also known as Divali or Deepavali depending on where you are, is India's biggest and most important holiday of the year. The festival gets its name from the row (avali) of clay lamps (deepa) that Indians light outside their homes to symbolize the inner light that protects from spiritual darkness. Diwali is celebrated over five days.
