

INTERNATIONAL TRANS DAY OF VISIBILITY



Happy International Transgender Day of Visibility! March 31, is a day that celebrates the joy and accomplishments of transgender and gender diverse folks. Transgender (often shortened to "trans") is an umbrella term that refers to people whose gender identity differs from that typically associated with the sex they were assigned at birth.

While there is still much work to be done to stop the oppression of and enshrine protections for the

Trans community, **International Transgender Day of Visibility** is a celebration of the **courage**, **creativity**, **diversity**, and **presence** of our Trans neighbors, consumers, and loved ones.
